

**MASONIC CHARITABLE FUND - SIVAKUMAR MURUGAIYAN
LION OF ERIN LODGE STUDY AWARD**

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Masonic Charitable Fund – Sivakumar Murugaiyan Lion of Erin Study Award is open to all Bachelor of Laws (LLB) and Juris Doctor (JD) students.
2. Applicants must be Singapore Citizens with impressive academic and co-curricular activities records, strong language skills and demonstrate leadership qualities.
3. Applicant must have a monthly household per capita (PCI) income of no more than S\$4,300.
4. The value of each study award is S\$7,500 and will be used within the awarded academic year (2 semesters) to offset the recipient's tuition fees.
5. Study award recipients are not required to serve a bond with SUSS but are expected to make satisfactory academic progress.
6. Recipients are not allowed to request for deferment of the study award.
7. The study awards are accorded on a yearly basis. Applicants may apply for the study award in the academic year that they are in need.
8. The study award may not, without the prior approval of the University, be held concurrently with any other awards.
9. Applicants must meet the admission requirements for the applied course of study. Prospective students must separately submit the online Admission application to SUSS and must be accepted before being awarded the study award.
10. Applicants are required to submit all relevant supporting documents together with the study award e-application. Otherwise, the application would be considered incomplete and will not be processed.
11. Shortlisted candidates will be notified to attend an interview by end October.
12. The University reserves the right to revoke the study award at any time if, in its opinion, the recipient's conduct or academic performance has not been satisfactory.

13. The University reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions for the study award at its sole discretion without prior notice.

14. The decision of SUSS on the selection of study award candidates is final and no appeal will be entertained.

A separate letter and agreement with the detailed terms and conditions (including the above terms and conditions) and others relating to the course of study will be given to all successful applicants.
